Short Description:

- Plan and facilitate Workshop Leader Spring Training

Summer '19 (approximately 60 hours):

- Update Workshop Leader resources (binders, training items, etc.)
- Plan Workshop Leader fall training in collaboration with Program Manager
- Co-facilitate Orientation Team training with Orientation Leadership
- Co-facilitate Orientation 2019 with Orientation Leadership

Fall '19 (approximately 70 hours):

- Conduct Returner Trainings
- Conduct Team Trainings
- Hold Office Hours
- Meet with Program Manager
- Coordinate Projects/Goals
- Attend to WL Concerns
- Review Coordinator Applications
- Conduct Coordinator Interviews
- Review Returner Applications
- Returner Selection

Spring '20 (approximately 65 hours):

- Review Workshop Leader applications and coordinate applicant interviews
- Hold interviews for the Workshop Leader position with the 2020 Coordinator
- Deliberate and select the 2020 Workshop Leader team alongside the Program Manager, 2020 Coordinator, and Director of the Shepard Center

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Applicants Must Be:

- a current or previous Workshop Leader
- in good academic standing at the University

If selected as the First Year Workshop Coordinator, you are required to help prepare and train the Workshop Leaders the week before the start of classes in August 2019, and you <u>CANNOT</u> serve as in any Residence Life, ASUP Executive, or Orientation roles, or participate in any other role that will conflict with the training and time commitment of the Coordinator position.
