

University of Portland's Response to Reports of Sexual or Gender-Based Harassment, Misconduct and Violence



Report of harassment, misconduct, or violence received by Public Safety, Residence Life, Student Conduct Coordinator, UP faculty or staff, or Title IX Coordinator.

Report is shared with Deputy Title IX Coordinator.

Report is received and documented as required by the US Department of Education.



Student is invited to meet with Deputy Title IX Coordinator and discuss potential options, including possible accommodations.

All options are provided to a student multiple times.

On and off campus resources provided to students.

Student's choice is supported and facilitated by Public Safety, Residence Life, Student Conduct Coordinator, Title IX, etc.

One goal of response process is to minimize the number of times a student needs to share perspective /information.
